

# Find Media for Class

Start here to find licensed, copyright-approved media options supported by the library.

I'm looking for a specific video title

I want to browse the streaming video offerings to find materials for my course.

Use the library's search box on the Library's homepage to search for a specific title of a film

Go to the Database List on the library's website. At the bottom of the page @ "Browse Database Types", click on video. You will see a list of all or part video databases in the library.

**I found a DVD I would like to use!**

The call number begins with DVDxxxx.

- I can go to the library and get the DVD to show in class.
- I can place it on reserve for my students

I did NOT find a streaming video in the above options and would like to explore other options

**I found a streaming video I would like to use!**

In the library's catalog, click on:

**This title is available electronically via:**

*The title of the Database*

Or **Watch Movie Online**

***Share link/Embed in MyLMUConnect/Brightspace***

I FOUND IT ON NETFLIX, AMAZON, HULU, etc.

Can the library get a subscription? – NO

Can I use my own personal subscription and stream it in class?

NO, as the license you signed is for personal use. However, you can ask your students to subscribe and watch it on their own.
